Warranty

Please note our marble and travertine products are unsealed. Damage, wear, or changes resulting from unprotected outdoor use, exposure to environmental conditions, or lack of maintenance are not covered under warranty.

Installation

For accuracy, we recommend the centre-centre screw measurements be created in the joinery only when you receive this item. Measurements may vary slightly due to the nature of this product. Please take care during installation, the screws should feel firm, but not extremely tight. Please also refrain from using electric tools to screw these in.

Core Rule: Protect from Acids & Stains

Marble is soft and porous.

- Acids (vinegar, lemon, cleaner) cause etching (dull marks)
- Oils & liquids cause stains.

Daily Care

- Wipe with a soft, dry microfiber cloth.
- For stickiness, use a damp cloth with warm water and a drop of pH-neutral soap.
- Dry immediately and thoroughly with a separate dry cloth.

Protection

- Seal with a stone sealer every 6-12 months to repel liquids.
- Wipe spills immediately, especially acidic ones.

What to Avoid

- NO vinegar, Windex, or harsh chemicals.
- NO abrasive scrubbers.
- NO letting liquids sit on the surface.

Summary: Clean gently, dry instantly, and seal regularly.

Risks Specific to Handles/Pulls:

Frequent Contact: They are touched constantly, transferring oils, sweat, and lotions from hands, which are primary staining agents.

Cleaning Overspray: During countertop or sink cleaning, cleaner spray can easily hit the handles, increasing exposure to acids or chemicals.

The Measures are Actionable for Handles:

- "Wipe with a soft cloth" is a direct action you perform on the handle.
- "Dry immediately and thoroughly" is the key to preventing water spots on the handle's surface
- "Use a sealer" is an application you perform directly on the handle to protect it.
- "Avoid chemicals and abrasives" warns against getting these substances on the handles during cleaning.
